### Kyo no Yakiniku HIRO

It is a yakiniku restaurant run by a butcher shop. Since it purchases whole animals, it provides quality Japanese Black beef at reasonable prices. It was the first yakiniku shop from the chain, and it attracts with its easy-to-enjoy barbecue style. You can order each item separately.

### KYOTOSENMARU Syakariki murasaki

The branch of a popular shop with many local fans. Our signature dish is the delicious soy sauce ramen with dried sardines and chicken soup. Toppings such as melty roast pork and meaty menma (bamboo shoots) are also popular. Don't miss the flat tsuke soba noodles.
