Established in 1915, Katayama Bunzaburo Shoten continues the tradition of the "Kyo Kanoko Shibori" (Kyoto-style fawn pattern tie-dye) technique, as well as passing on the infinite possibilities of Shibori tie-dye to the present. It makes colorful and innovative artistic products, including scarves, clothes, accessories, hats, bags and parasols for everyday use, and interior goods such as noren (Japanese shop curtains) and Shibori lanterns. Shibori's seemingly endless orderly rows of irregular textures evoke a Japanese style of beauty that is highly appreciated around the world.

**Everyday goods and folkcraft deeply rooted in Japanese life.**

Located near the World Heritage Site of Nijo Castle, Kura Daily Store is filled with ecological everyday products born in Japan, that used to be a part of daily Japanese life. It offers tableware restored by "kintsugi", the traditional technique of repairing broken pottery with lacquer and gold powder. There is also a large selection of hand towels and handkerchiefs, as well as tableware dating from the Meiji (1868-1912) to the early Showa period (1926-1989).

Japanese kitchen/household hardware and tools

**Originally made authentic kitchen knives, traditional Japanese rain gutters and convenient cooking utensils.**

Located a 7 minute walk from JR Kyoto Station, Kotani Kanamono was originally a blacksmith's shop and has a history of over 100 years. It later prospered as a hardware store, doing business with many local carpenters and building contractors, and has a selection of over 15,000 items, from architectural hardware, metal fittings and tools to kitchen equipment, professional cookware, baking tools and household goods. Japanese knives made with traditional methods by craftsmen are especially popular as gifts.
